



#### **About the Program**

Roadway streetlights illuminate roadways which can improve both traffic safety as well as public safety. This application allows residents and community members to request street lighting on the local streets within their community. Applicants must be a property owner or tenant with an address along the street(s).

If you would like the Office of Commissioner Rodney Ellis to consider funding the installation of streetlights along your street or throughout your community, please complete this application and submit it to **PlanTogether@cp1.hctx.net** or submit an online application. *This program requires a petition and signed affidavit.* Please note, completing this form is not a commitment that Harris County will install streetlights, but will begin the assessment process.

Note: Applications from TIRZs, MUDs, Management Districts, and other similar organization will be considered through this program however, a commitment to pay for long-term operations and maintenance will be required from the requesting entity. Private developers are excluded from this program.

## **Street Lighting Program**Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



- Q: When will I know if my applicant streets are selected for a future Street Lighting project?
- **A:** We anticipate announcing projects in June 2026.
- Q: Can we use electronic signatures for the petition?
- **A:** We are required to collect legal signatures as part of the petition process. If an electric signature is an accurate visual representation of the signers signature, then it can be used.
- Q: Can I submit an application after February 28, 2026?
- **A:** Yes, however your application will be part of the FY 2027 review cycle and project announcements will not occur for FY 2027 projects until Summer 2027.
- Q: Can I just get a single light in front of my house?
- **A:** Due to CenterPoint lighting standards we will assess entire street segments instead of single locations to create a comprehensive lightning plan.
- Q: Who will maintain lights after installation?
- **A:** CenterPoint will own and maintain all street lights. If you would like to report a street light outage, please do so at <a href="https://gis.centerpointenergy.com/sloreporting/">https://gis.centerpointenergy.com/sloreporting/</a>.
